

2nd Conditional



If I **won** the money, I'd **buy** the new Iphone.

Impossible in the present! 0 %

If I **had** money, I **would** buy a new car.

If mum **cooked** chicken, I **would/could** eat it all.

If the weather **were** good, I **would/could** go to the beach now.

If I were you, I **wouldn't** (would+not) tell lies.

If it **didn't rain**, we **would** like London.

Unless it rained, we **would** like London.

If + **past**

simple(didn't/ed) → **would/could** + **bare infinitive**

- Unless = if not
- Were instead of was

If I **didn't have** a lesson **now**, I **would/could** cook.(2)-IMPOSSIBLE FOR NOW



But

If I **don't have** a lesson, I **will/may** go out tomorrow.(1)-
>present/future,possibility
