Instructions

The cards can be used in a more focused version of the traditional "I spy with my little eye" game. They can be used to enhance auditory skills, phonemic awareness, and turn-taking. Students can practice the basic alphabet sounds, the digraph sounds, and some C-V-C word groups.

For very young learners you can start with one card at a time and add cards as they progress in their studies.

This resource is quite versatile as it can also be used for dictation practice, or as a part of a TPR activity in which you can hide the cards and ask students to find them. Another way to use them would be to distribute them randomly to your students and assign them specific sound(s). Then they should interact with their classmates to find the card representing the sound(s) they have been assigned.
